**MX 777 Spotty Crop** – MX Bar Ranch, one of our major bucking horse breeding stallions over the past 16 years



Spotty Crop is an appaloosa cross stallion we purchased 17 years ago as a two year old from a reservation south of us here in Alberta. We bucked him the first couple of years and really liked his style and consistency, so we put him into our breeding program. We had bucked him in both the saddlebronc and bareback riding over the years and he went to the Canadian Cowboy Association Finals in the bareback riding, as well as the Lakeland Rodeo Association Finals.

# <u>2010</u>

On to 2010, we only had 3 foals off of him that year, we lost one, but the other two are in our breeding program, MX072 Tribal Ways which is a half sister to NFR Black Coffee #40 of Pete Carr and the other mare is MX073 Alberta Snow which is a full sister to multiple NFR MX48 Alberta Child.

#### 2011-2013

2011 and 2012, we gave our mares a break and in 2013 we had 5 foals off of Spotty and one grandfoal (out of the MX103 Good Boy stallion we sold): MX301 Marta we just started bucking this year (2017) in the UBHA Futurities in the bareback riding, she's getting top marks and the cowboys are winning the futurities on her. We just sold her to Bridwell Pro Rodeos.

We also had MX374 Mary that we were bucking in the UBHA dummy futurities in (2016) and she made it to the UBHA Finals in Las Vegas. If her dummy didn't jump over her withers during her ride, we probably would have won it! Her and MX371 Momma's Boy, both at the 3-year-old UBHA Finals were purchased by Bridwell Pro Rodeos, and Tim started bucking them this year (2017) in the bareback riding. At St. Paul Rodeo on July 1<sup>st</sup>, Mary, rode by Tilden Hooper was leading the rodeo with 84 points and Momma's Boy, rode by Kaycee Field was second with 83 points.

# <u>2014</u>

The 2014 foal season, we only had two late colts, Spotty had got kicked by a mare and had to heal up before putting him back with a couple open mares, so one of those offspring MX470 Alberta Smoke which is a full brother to Joe Simon's Canadian Smoke and our MX371 Momma's Boy will be kept as a breeding stallion to replace Spotty one day (As of 2018, he's been put with a handful of mares). The other foal, a filly MX471 Betty Lou (full sister to MX 375 Rock Your Socks and MX 871 Sassy Sister) was bucked a couple times with a dummy, and we really like her, she may stay in our breeding program as well:

Mamacita was sold in December of 2017 at the Benny Binion Bucking Horse Sale in Las Vegas to JD Hamaker with Summit Pro Rodeo. She sold as a two year old for \$16,000.

# <u>2017</u>

2017 was a big year for Spotty offspring. We had 8 foals that year, out of those, 6 have gone to other contractors into their breeding programs, and we kept one mare that will be a replacement for her dam which is a maternal sister to NFR MX105 Seniora.

## <u>2018</u>

Six Spotty foals brought in the spring at the MX Bar Ranch in 2018. We just put a dummy trip on these youngsters to get them used to what their jobs will be here in January of 2020. We are currently offering two of these colts for sale to the Bucking Horse Breeders Association Super Stakes Sale coming February 11<sup>th</sup>, 2020. It's going to be a great sale with some great genetics.

### <u>2019</u>

This past year, 2019, we had two foals by Spotty: a filly which was a twin – we call her Born to Be Wild and a stud colt out of a maternal sister to multiple X NFR horses MX48 Alberta Child and MX374 Mary.

Spotty Crop has been a great stallion for us, crossed with the different bloodlines of mares that we have, he has worked on them all.

Out of the years that we have bred with him, we have gotten high percentages of offspring that have turned out to be NFR horses, excellent Pro horses and also great breeding stock we have kept and put into our program, plus sold to other contractors. We are just starting to get his grand-foals out of his offspring and those are promising to be great as well.

We have never bred for quantity, only quality, as you can see by the low numbers we breed every year, but it has paid off for us. We now have a lot of Spotty's fillies in our P a g e 19 | 20

breeding program and have brought in new blood in order to continue on with our program. We don't believe in 'stack' or 'line' breeding, although many guys have had some good success with that, but we will keep using him on our current mares until he decides he's ready to retire.

We've proven him as a bucker, and he's proven himself as a great sire.

He is now recorded as an Accredited Stallion with the Bucking Horse Breeders Association bucking horse registry because of his offspring making the NFR.
